

DUAL ENROLLMENT WITH AVE MARIA UNIVERSITY

Enrollment process:

1. Students apply as Dual Enrollment students by going here <u>https://www.avemaria.edu/apply-now-1/</u> and clicking on Start your Application and then on to JumpStart Dual Enroll.

2. After application, Bailey Timmis from our Admissions department will contact them and guide the students through the process.

3. At the end of the process, students will get an Ave Maria email address and access to Canvas (the learning management system where the courses are hosted).

4. Once students are admitted, Mr. Gabriel Martinez will get in contact with them, advise them regarding the courses they should take, and register them for the right course. (In nearly all cases, the best first courses to take will be COMP 101 and CORE 101.)

5. Both Mr. Timmis and Mr. Martinez will remain in contact with the students to make sure the course is going well.

7. Please remember that when you enroll in a college, are accepted, and start taking courses (even these Dual Enrollment courses) the grades WILL be permanently recorded in your college transcripts. Follow proper procedures for dropping a course if you do not want to continue with the course.

- Pricing: \$750.00 per semester course
- 10% off for Aquinas Learning students (you will need an authorization letter from Aquinas Learning Dual Enrollment Department.)
- Course Options are subject to availability: (These are one semester courses that will count for college credits as listed as well as 1 year high school credit.)
